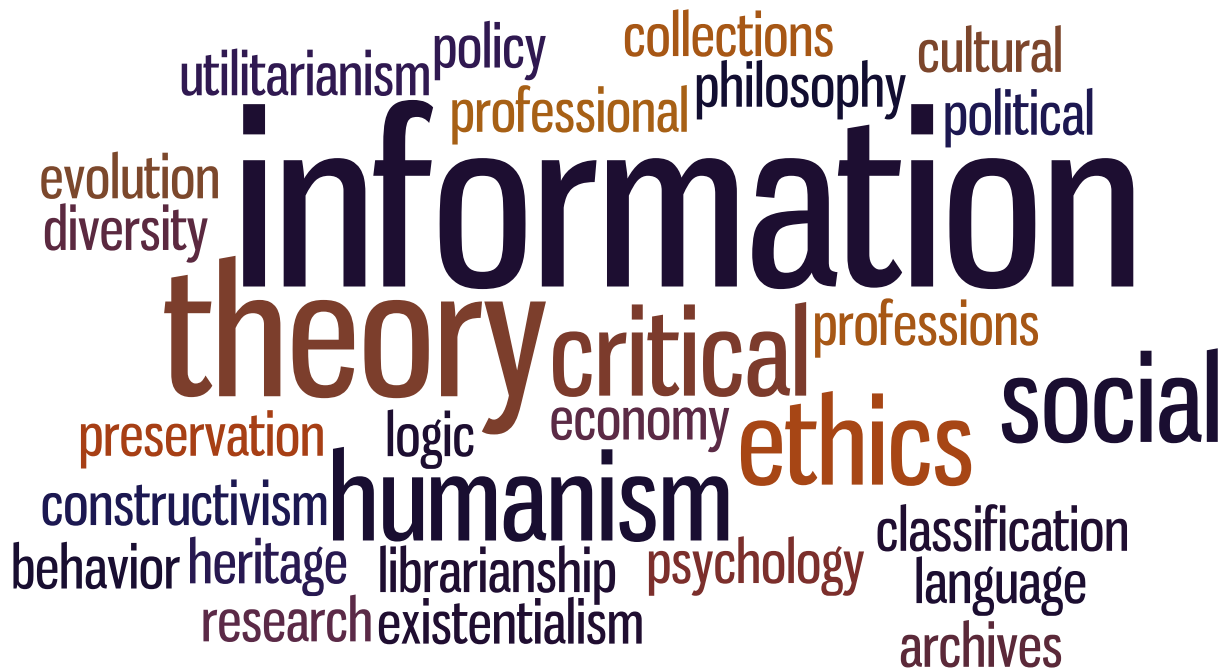

Ethical issues, including research and professional ethics, are also discussed. Three hours of field observation are required.
